

Photoshop Elements: Orange and Teal Look

In this lesson, learn how to create a cinematic orange and teal look for your image. The orange and teal look is very popular in cinema and photos, especially landscape photos with blue skies and golden tones. The orange and teal look can also look good on some portraits.

To create the orange and teal look:

1. Open a photo and make basic adjustments before applying this look.
2. In the **Layers** panel, create a new **Hue/Saturation** adjustment layer.
3. In the **Adjustments** panel, set the **Master channel** to **-20**.
4. From the drop-down list, select **Reds**. Set the **Reds channel** to **+20**.
5. From the drop-down list, select **Blues**. Set the **Blues channel** to **-20**.
6. Optionally, in the **Layers** panel, set the blending mode to **Color**.
7. If desired, reduce the effect by lowering the **Opacity** of the adjustment layer.

To finish the look, add a faded effect:

1. In the **Layers** panel, create a new **Levels** adjustment layer.
2. Set the **Output Levels** to **Black 20** and **White 235**.
