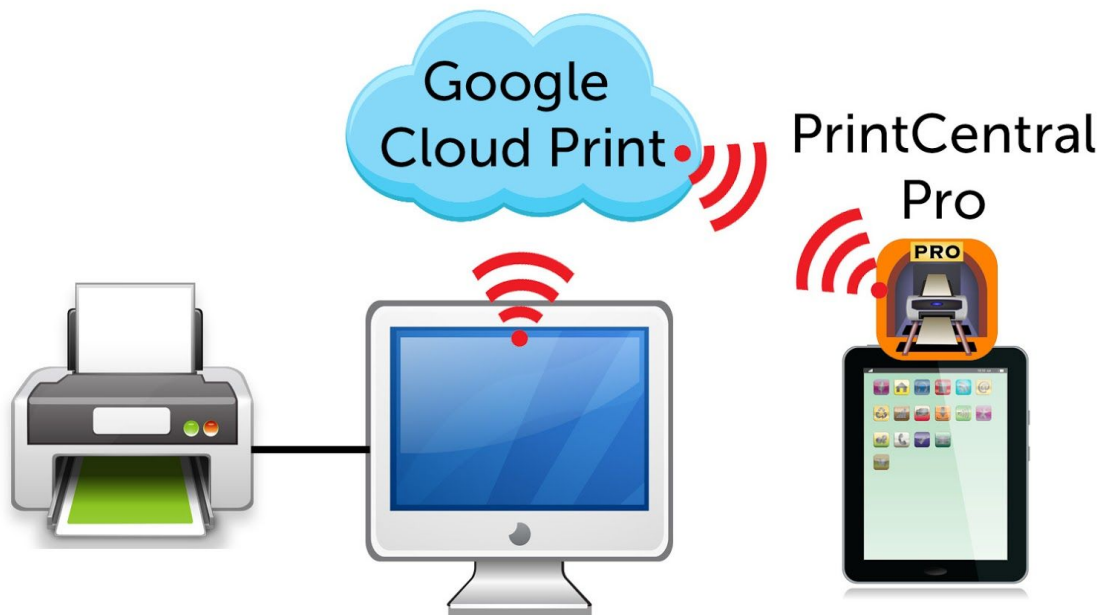


iPad: Print to a Wired Printer



You can print from your iPad to a wired printer that is connected to a desktop computer. To print to a wired printer, you need:

- The printer that is connected by cable to your PC.
- A PC that is connected to the Internet.
- Google Cloud Print on the PC
- The PrintCentral Pro app on your iPad.

Set Up Google Cloud Print

Google Cloud Print is a web-based service that enables you to print to a wired printer from any device that can access the Internet, including your iPad. You must set up Google Cloud Print on the PC to which your printer is connected.

To set up Google Cloud Print:

1. Open the Chrome browser on your PC.
2. In the address bar, type **chrome://devices** and press **Enter**.
3. Under **Classic Printers**, click **Add printers**.
4. Select the printers you want to add.
5. Click **Add printer(s)**

Set Up PrintCentral Pro

You can use the PrintCentral Pro app with Google Cloud Print to print a document from your iPad to your wired printer over the Internet.

Download the PrintCentral Pro app from the App Store. To set up Google Cloud Print in PrintCentral Pro, create a test document in Notes.

To set up Google Cloud Print in PrintCentral Pro:

1. Open the test document in Notes.
2. Tap the **Share** icon.
3. Tap **Print with PCL Pro**.
4. Tap **Google Cloud Printing**.
5. Enter your Google username (email address).
6. Tap **Connect**.
7. Choose your **Google account**.
8. Tap **Allow** to let PrintCentral Pro manage your printers. Your printers are added to the Printers (WiFi) list.
9. Select the wired printer that is connected to your PC.

Print Using PrintCentral Pro

To print to your home printer using PrintCentral Pro:

1. Open a document.
2. Tap the **Share** icon.
3. Tap **Print with PCL Pro**.
4. The **Print** dialogue box opens to the last printer you used. If you have set up and selected your printer as described above, this will be the printer connected to your desktop computer.
5. Tap **Printer Options** to select print options such as number of copies and orientation.
6. Tap **Print**.
7. Alternatively, tap **Choose** to select a different printer.
